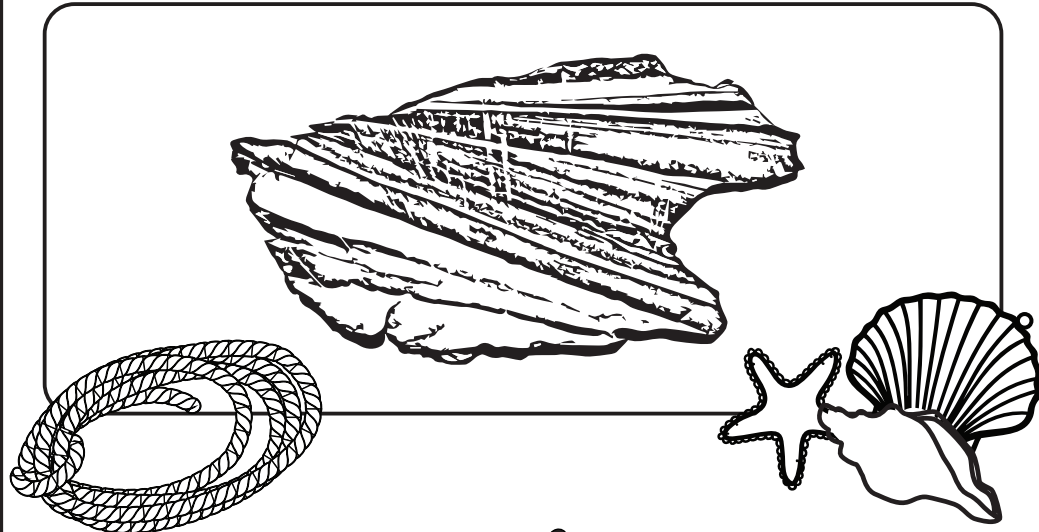

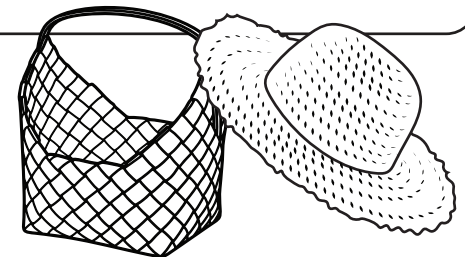

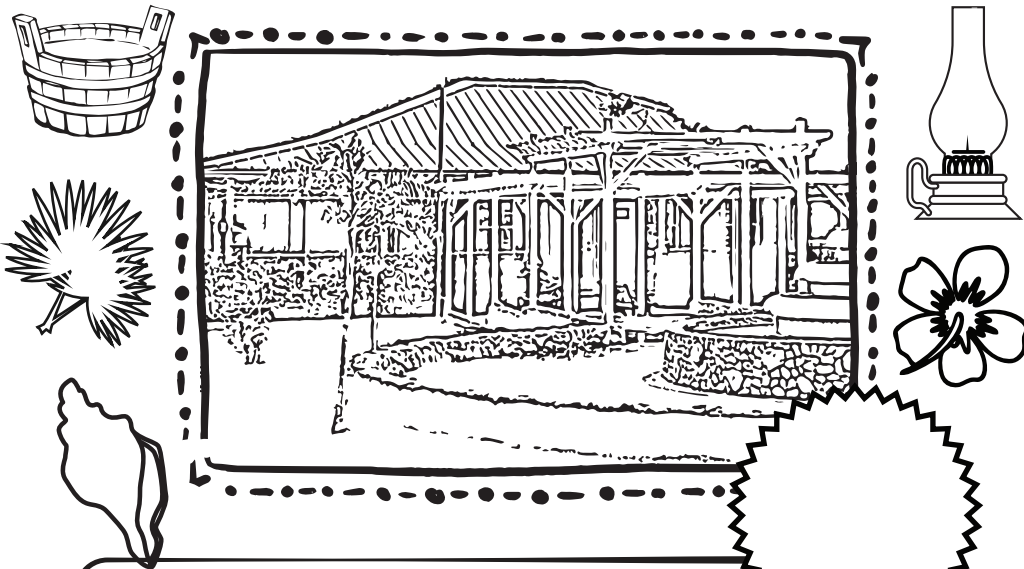

CAYMAN BRAC HERITAGE HOUSE



The Cayman Brac Heritage House is a modern version of an old Caymanian home, featuring a wrap round verandah, trellises and even a fountain. In addition to a wealth of both native and imported trees and flora, artifacts include the Lazzari leather tannery troughs (vats), wells and a pump house.

To create the book:

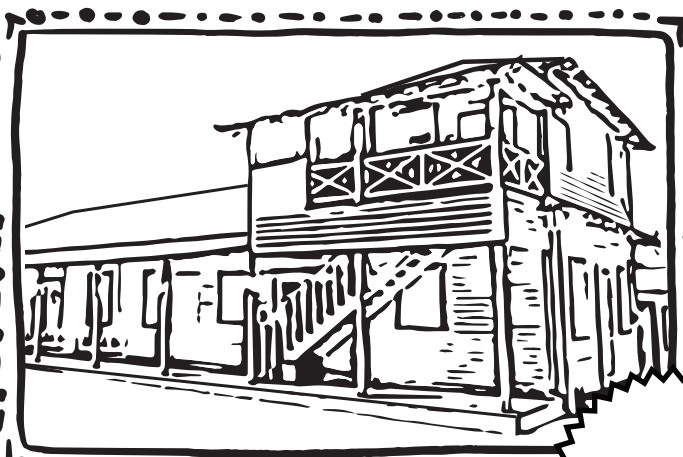
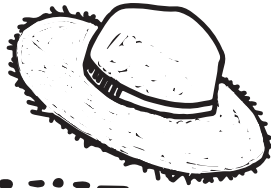
- You will need:

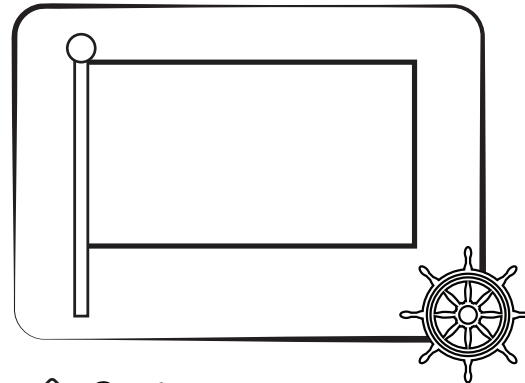
